

To encourage broad participation at our conference, NWWN is offering a limited number of scholarships and reduced fees for those who would otherwise be unable to attend. In addition to our student volunteer options [listed at the bottom of the <u>Registration page</u>] individuals can apply for a reduced or waived fee and assistance with travel and hotel accommodations.

In order to be eligible for travel and hotel assistance, you must be:

- Travelling within the United States
- Committed to attending the entire NWWN conference (Tuesday-Thursday)
- Travelling to attend the conference (*i.e.*, we will not consider requests that extend beyond +/-1 day of the conference).
- Able to make your own travel arrangements for which you will be reimbursed by NWWN per agreement made prior to your booking

Priority will be given to applicants who meet one or more of the following criteria:

- Member of an under-represented community (*e.g.*, environmental justice community)
- Early career individuals, including students
- Individuals who have made significant contributions to the NWWN but who could not otherwise attend the conference due to financial hardship
- Members of the working waterfront workforce (e.g., commercial fishermen) who could not otherwise attend the conference due to financial hardship
